BETWEEN

The **KLE Vishwanath Katti Institute of Dental Sciences, Belagavi**, a constituent unit of KLE Academy of Higher Education & Research, (KAHER) (KLE Deemed-to-be University) having its office at Nehru Nagar Belagavi – 590010, India represented by its Head of Department of Oral Pathology & Microbiology, **Dr Punnya Rao**, herein / after to be referred to as "**KAHER'S KLE VK IDS**" which expression shall unless repugnant to context thereof, mean and include its successors and permitted to assign as the **First Party**

AND

The KLE Technological University, Hubballi represented by the Dean **Dr Uma Mudenagudi** herein / after to be referred to as "**KLETech**" which expression shall unless repugnant to context thereof, mean and include its successors and permitted to assign as the **Second Party**

This MoU sets down the mutually agreed broad framework for joint research and academic activities in various fields of interest. It also incorporates the modalities for collaboration.

1. PREAMBLE :-

KAHER'S KLEVKIDS is a private Dental College established in the year 1985, situated in Belagavi, having state-of-art infrastructure for patient care, specialized research activities, training programmes and highly trained and qualified faculty, administrative and technical staff.

KLETech is one of leading state private university in north Karnataka situated in Hubballi. The University has extraordinary infrastructure, specialized researchers, administrative and technical staff, training programmes and research activities.

The **KAHER'S KLEVKIDS** and **KLETech** are premier institutions and collaborative research programmes would be of considerable mutual benefit.

2) PURPOSE :-

KAHER'S KLEVKIDS and KLETech desire to implement in the areas of mutual interest, cooperative and collaborative activities, which would address multidisciplinary scientific, technological and educational problems of relevance to the country within fields that are mutually acceptable in accordance with the law following general forms of cooperation. This is facilitated by the instrument of this MoU as follows:-

Joint research activities for translational research areas as mutually agreed upon by involving faculty, research scholars and students from different departments of both institutions abide by the rules.

Visits and exchange: There will be provision for visit and exchange of faculty, research scholars, staff and students between the institutes for research related activities. There can be joint organization of events (workshops, seminars, symposia, lectures) and mutual sharing of data online and offline.

Intellectual Property: Important research findings and inventions developed under the collaboration may be published/ presented/ patented with mutual consent of the collaborators. Any returns of commercialization of the Intellectual property will be shared in proportion to be decided mutually by both the parties on case-to-case basis and exchange of letters.

Non-exclusivity of the MoU: Except the provisions regarding Intellectual Property, either party or both parties together have unrestricted right to seek additional funds for and/or to cooperate with any agency/institute for any of the projects covered by MoU.

Rights for modifications: The contents of the MoU may be modified or changed by mutual agreement of the parties hereto in writings. It shall then be effective from the date of modification.

Confidentiality : Party I and Party II shall maintain the confidentiality of the data. Patient related data shall be kept confidential. The data will be collected only after obtaining ~~written consent in language known to the consenting patient / person~~. The identity of the patient / person shall be always kept confidential by both **Party I & II**.



Disagreements/ Differences: Any disagreements/ differences of opinion/ disputes regarding the interpretations of the provisions of the MoU shall be resolved by mutual consultation of the signatories.

Governing Law: All research activities undertaken jointly by **KAHER'S KLE VKIDS** and **KLETech** under this MoU will be governed by the Laws of the Republic of India.

The implementation of these activities, including all financial arrangements will be developed mutually for specific projects based on this MoU.

The tenure of the MoU shall be for **three years** from the date of signing the MoU. Unless opted otherwise by either of the signatory parties to this MoU, tenure shall be renewed automatically for another three years from the date of expiry of the first tenure.



This memorandum of understanding (this Understanding) is executed on 16 August 2021 by and between

With

GSR Institute of Craniomaxillofacial and Facial Plastic Surgery, 17-1-383/55, Vinay nagar colony, I.S. Sadan, Saidabad Hyderabad 500059 Andhra Pradesh, India a premier hospital and Institute (Hereinafter referred as GSR Institute, which expression shall, unless repugnant to the subject or context there of, be deemed to include and mean its nominees, successors and permitted substitutes or assigns) on another PART either or both of which may be referred to as a Party or the Parties, respectively as the context demands.

WHEREAS

A. The University desires to provide training and education in the field of Craniomaxillary and Facial Plastic Surgery. The training for the postgraduates will be for a duration of 1 to 2 month during their 3rd year of Postgraduation

B.KLE University is committed to promote & develop higher education and impart education & qualification in the medical technology. The University has conceded to GSR Institute on the terms and subject to the conditions contained herein

C.Based on the complementary strengths of the University and GSR Institute, the University is desirous of collaborating with GSR Institute, which would provide education, research and training to the postgraduates

NOW THIS MOU WITNESSES AS FOLLOWS THE ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF EITHER PARTY

Roles and Responsibilities of the University:

The University & GSR Institute will collaboratively arrange for the training to be conducted at GSR Hospital based at Hyderabad, India by faculty that includes Dr S M Kotrashetti, Professor, Department of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery, in-house faculty, and the surgical faculty of GSR Hospital, Hyderabad.

1. The University & GSR Institute appoint Dr S M Kotrashetti and Dr Gosla Reddy as Course Coordinators in order to facilitate proper coordination between the University and GSR Institute covering all aspects training. Dr S M Kotrashetti will be permitted to travel to GSR Institute for Coordinating and training on need basis not more than 40 days in a year by the KLE University
2. Faculty of the Department of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery, KLE VK Institute of Dental Sciences can also visit and train in the GSR Institute with prior permission from the KLE University and GSR Institute
3. All students shall be governed by the academic regulation framed by the University, which shall be provided by the University to the students at the start of the Course.
4. The GSR institute shall arrange to provide a certificate of completion of training for the students. Assessment of the students shall be solely carried out by the University.
5. The University shall maintain both in physical as well as in an electronic format (wherever possible or available) the details, (including academic records) of all students enrolled for the training and shall provide the same to KLE University on request.

Roles and Responsibilities of GSR Institute:

- 1 GSR Institute shall ensure necessary facilities are provided for surgical training
2. GSR Institute undertakes to strictly follow the Course Curriculum and the teaching plan approved by the University.

Team Termination and Liability:

This understanding shall come into force and take effect from the date first written above and shall be valid for a period of five (5) years and may be renewed thereafter by the parties upon mutual consent

This understanding may be terminated by either party by providing 60 (Sixty) days written notice to the other party before the beginning of the academic year, and the termination would be effective at the end of the notice period.

Any termination of the Understanding shall be on the understanding that students who have already enrolled in any of the courses as at the date of termination shall remain entitled to complete their respective training. The obligation of the parties shall continue to be in force during such period, notwithstanding any termination of the understanding

Preamble:

The Memorandum of Understanding is a bridge made between the “KAHER’s KLE V.K. Institute of Dental Sciences, Belagavi, Karnataka” and PMNM Dental College Bagalkot, Karnataka is witnessed as follows:

Recognizing the mutual interest in the fields of research, development, educational training, patient care and other facilities & dissemination of knowledge on long term non-profit basis.

Recognizing the importance of the role of an Institute in research and as a tertiary care center in promoting National and International collaboration and increased contribution to social development services.

Hereby, the Institutes agree to establish collaboration in terms of Academics, Research and patient care during the pendency of MoU according to terms and conditions set out in the articles following hereunder.

The words “The two Institutions” and “collaborating Institution” in the Memorandum of Understanding refer to KAHER’s KLE V.K. Institute of Dental Sciences, Belagavi, Karnataka and PMNM Dental College, Bagalkot, Karnataka. Hereafter ‘KAHER’s KLE V.K. Institute of Dental Sciences, Belagavi, Karnataka’ will be referred as “**Party I**” and ‘PMNM Dental College, Bagalkot, Karnataka’ will be referred as “**Party II**”

Article-1: FIELF OF COLLABORATION

Collaboration between the two Institutions may be established within any field related to health science and technology of mutual interest and in particular research and patient care. Extensions to other areas will be made through further amendments to the present Memorandum of Understanding.

Article-2: EXCHANGE OF STAFF AND STUDENTS

2.1. Faculty and students of either Institute, who wish to undertake a short term programme or field work/research work at the other Institution, will be assisted by the host Institution in getting authorization, finding accommodation, library and laboratory facilities; provided the programme is accepted by the home Institution and has at least one supervisor from each Institution. The externship of such student/faculty will be equal / more or less in number for the exchange. The cost of travel and accommodation will be borne by individuals/home institution.

2.2 Parties will exchange proposals concerning the topics, persons, type of research, tests and periods of specific research reasonably in advance of the proposed visit.

2.3. The facilities available in the respective institution shall be extended for the patient care to the referred patients in the subsidized manner or as per prevailing practices at the host Institution offering the facilities.

Article-3: **TRAINING OF STUDENTS**

3.1 Both parties (I & II) will provide facilities for observation and practical training for students of other party. Suitable and adequate accommodation will be provided, subject to the availability. In any case there shall be no financial liability on part of the host Institute.

Article-4: **JOINT SUPERVISION OF STUDENT PROJECT**

4.1 As a part of collaboration, the faculty of both Institutes may jointly supervise projects of students.

4.2 The details of the project of students will be worked out by the respective persons of both the Institutions.

4.3 The student should first submit the project proposal which has to be authorized by both the institutions.

Article-5: **RESEARCH PROJECTS**

There is possibility of twinning faculty and students of the two Institutions in common research. The **expenditure incurred** for the Post Graduate Training, Projects and Research will be borne by the Postgraduate Students / faculty of the respective Institute/home institution.

- a. The proposal of any research project to be taken up by either of the parties should be discussed and approved well in advance by both the parties. Research projects and the composition of research teams will be approved by both the institutions. Efforts will be made to evaluate the need for participating staff and location of the research activity.
- b. Institutional Ethics Board clearance of both the Institutes should be obtained from both the parties before taking up any research work.
- c. **Party I and II** are permitted to access all the details on the progress of the study, data and results on the joint studies or projects undertaken under this venture.

- d. Each research project will be jointly led by the both institutions' team leader, who will be responsible for reporting on the project status. Concerned postgraduate and faculty shall submit progress report at periodical intervals (in case of Research, once in three months) to the collaborating institutes.
- e. Both the parties will put all efforts inviting grants for various research projects from funding sources. Efforts will be made to write and conduct research project by both institutions and provide information about ongoing research activities in order to establish contacts and collaborations between professionals working within the same field.
- f. For externally funded project, rules and regulations of both the parties will be strictly adhered to depending upon the Institute of the principal investigator (PI).
- g. The **attendance** of externship student and faculty during the posting at the **either of the Institute** will be maintained by both parties and shall be exchanged.

Article-6: **INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS (IPR)**

All Intellectual property solely conceived and/or developed by Party I during the course of this agreement shall be owned by Party I. All intellectual property solely conceived and/or developed by party II during the course of this agreement shall be owned by Party II. Intellectual property jointly conceived and/or developed by Party I and Party II will be jointly owned by Party I and Party II. Both Party I and Party II agree towards the protection when the application of such intellectual property for commercial or other purposes on mutually acceptable terms with equal shares. All the provisions of this article hold true only for exchange of the students/faculty to other institution.

Article-7: **FUNDING AND FINANCE**

The party doing the research project will have the responsibility to finance the project & the other party in which the project is been carried out will provide the infrastructure and other related facilities. The exact nature of funding and finance to be decided mutually at the starting of each project with a separate MoU as mentioned in "Article 13".

Externally funded projects would be as per "Article 5 (f)".

Article-8: **LINK MANAGEMENT AND ADMINISTRATION**

Negotiation, implementation and co-ordination of the Memorandum of Understanding falls under the responsibility of both, the Principal of the Party I and the Principal of Party II. The MoU will take effect from the date it is signed by the Principal of the Party I and the Principal of the Party II.

Article-9: **GENERAL PROVISIONS**

9.1 Party I and II will carry out joint research as a follow up to this Memorandum of Understanding. The activities must be carried out in accordance with appropriate laws and regulations existing in country and will undertake to not violate any of the statutory requirements as laid by the concerned bodies appointed by the Government of India for time to time.

9.2 Party I and II shall initiate an exchange of research publications, publication lists and other official publications. This will be provided with adequate security as far as intellectual property laws are concerned as mentioned in article No. 6.

9.3 All publications resulting from the collaboration between the two institutions will be mentioned in the scientific reports of the institutions. Likewise, this MoU must also be mentioned in all formal presentation, which results from the collaboration under the terms of this MoU.

9.4 This MoU is signed subject to appropriate authorization of both sides.

Article-10: **NON-DISCLOSURE**

In case of joint research and consultancy projects taken up by Party I and Party II, no party will disclose any investigation to media/any unauthorized person from each institute in any form whether electronic/print without mutual consent and approval by coordination committee.

Article-11: **SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES**

Any difference or dispute between the parties concerning the interpretation and/or implementation and/or application of any of the provision of the MoU shall be settled amicably through mutual consultation and/or negotiation between the parties. In case, the dispute occurs between both the parties and if the same is not resolved through negotiations or by adopting amicable measures, in that case the matter will be settled through arbitration and the Arbitrator will be appointed with the mutual consent of both the parties, without reference to any tribunal or court.


Article-12: **VALIDITY PERIOD**

- Both universities will try to seek external funding success to facilitate these exchanges.
