Sub: Permission to start Dental Mechanic & Dental Hygienst course in KLES.Institute of Dental Sciences,Belgaum.
Ref: As per reference letter No MET 97:93-96 dt.02.07.98 The Chairman Para Medical Board & the Director of Medical Education dept. Bangalore.

PREAMBLE : As per the reference letter cited above, from the Chairman, DME Bangalore. The KLE's Institute of Dental Sciences Belgaum has submitted an application to start Dental Mechanic and Dental Hygienst course in KLES.Institute of Dental Sciences, Belgaum. Inspection committee has formulated to see the available infrastructure facilities. The said committee Inspected the Institution to know the Infrastructure facilities available and submitted their report. This said committee report was submitted to Para Medical Board. The Board has accepted the report of the committee recommended and permitted to take the admission in the strength of 10 students in each course from the academic year 1998, since this is the order.

GOVERNMENT ORDER NO: HFW 156 MME 98 BANGALORE DATED 11.07.98

After Examining the Preamble the Government has permitted to KLE'S.Institute of Dental Sciences, Belgaum to start Dental Mechanic and Dental Hygienst Course from the year 1998-99 onwards with the admission of 10 students Dental Mechanic & Hygienst course permitted to start on the following conditions.

- 1) Every year in the month of August admission procedure should be completed and list of the candidate should reach Para Medical Board during the month of Sept.
- 2) Before starting the course the affiliation fees of Rs.20,000 and renewal fees for affiliation of Rs.5000/- should be paid to Para Medical Board.
- 3) The Institute should strictly follow the rules and regulations, laid down by the Para Medical Board regarding age, qualification, duration of the course, syllabus and pattern of the Exam.
- 4) At the completion of the course the candidates should appear examination conducted by Para Medical Board.
- 5) Admission strenght should not be exceed and restrict to the sanction strength.
- 6) For the sanction course the Institution should posses the requirement Teaching & Non-Teaching Staff and other facilities.
- 7) For every inspection the Institution has to pay Rs.5000 to Para Medical Board.
- 8) No grants or aids will be granted from the Government to this course.

- 9) The Institution has to register in the Para Medical Board and follow the rules and regulation of the Board.
- 10) In view of the students education to provide well equipped class room laboratory etc.
- 11) For para medical course the minimum qualification is candidate should have passed in IInd PUC.
- 12) The Institution has to agree to admit 20% of the sanctioned strength from the Govt. selected.
- 13) Prescribed fees should be collected from the students as per Government of norms.
- 14) Rs.200 admission fees collected from the students and remitt to the Para Medical Board.
- 15) For Para Medical courses admission should be made during the month of January and June of every year.
